With its famous graphic collection, the Albertina is considered one of the most important museums in the world. Here, one can find Dürer's "The Field Hare" and Klimt's studies of women. Once the largest Habsburg living quarters, the Albertina sits majestically on the south end of the Imperial Palace on one of the last remaining bastions of Vienna. The last enlargement of the collection - the Baltliner Collection - makes the Albertina Austria's only museum in which the hitherto existing gap in international, classical modern art can be closed with major works of French Impressionism and Post-Impressionism, the German Expressionism, the Fauves and the Russian avant-garde. The highlights are the over 30 Pablo Picassos, including ten major paintings and many drawings.

We will see buildings like the Museum of Fine Arts, the Museum of Natural History, the City Hall, the Burgtheater, the Parliament, the University, and many more. The highlight of our excursion is a tour through Schönbrunn Palace, the summer residence of the former Imperial House of Austria.

We start our tour by bus to Wachau, the romantic Danube valley situated before Vienna. Our first destination is Melk, where we visit the magnificent Baroque monastery and admire the breathtaking view of the Danube. You have the opportunity to enjoy lunch in the monastery restaurant, afterwards we go on a boat trip on the Danube, which takes us from Melk to Spitz. Past the picturesque town of Dürnstein with the Kuenringer castle, where 800 years ago King Richard I Lionheart was held prisoner, we continue by bus to Krems. In Krems, in the course of a short walk, you will have the opportunity to take a look at the medieval town center with the Sgraffito-houses. After that, we will return to Vienna.
